ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT

July 1 - September 20, 2019

July 26 – 27, 2019 – Conducted Senior Citizens Social Pension Payout for 3,837 beneficiaries within Bislig City (1,358 Males; 2,479 Females). Paymasters were from the DSWD Caraga. Actual paid beneficiaries was 3,693 while the unpaid beneficiaries was 144.

August 1, 2019 – FSCABC Federation President Franciso P. Fernandez, Jr. attended the Provincial Federation Meeting at Tandag, Surigao del Sur. During their meeting, they were required to submit list of Senior Citizens ageing 80 years old and above for possible stipend. No other details (amount, date and venue of release) were discussed yet.

August 14, 2019 – Public hearing at the Legislative Session Hall, Bislig City for the Proposed Unified Senior Citizens Federation Ordinance of Bislig City.

September 5, 2019 – FSCABC Fed. Pres. Francisco P. Fernandez Jr. attended the C/Municipal Federation of Senior Citizens Monthly Meeting at Tandag, Surigao del Sur. He also submitted to the Provincial Office the List of Senior Citizens 80 years old and above as requirement for the Proposed Stipend for said seniors. Amount, date and venue (if said proposal is approved) is yet to be announced.

The DSWD Caraga hired additional two (2) validators to visit different barangays within Bislig City for validation, assessment and interview of un-validated active Senior Citizens Social Pension beneficiaries, as well as, those who are on the waiting list.

September 12, 2019 (PM) – A representative from the DSWD Caraga Regional Office pre-accredited the Bislig City Senior Citizens Center for the upcoming Accreditation (Renewal) in compliance with the provisions of RA7876 (Senior Citizens Center Act of the Philippines) and RA4373 (An Act to Regulate the Practice of Social Work and the Operation of Social Work Agencies in the Philippines and for Other Purposes). Our accreditation will expire on November 2, 2019 and with a validity of three (3) years.

1. Happy Desk	639	1,020	1,659	Senior Citizens coming from different barangays were satisfactorily entertained and accommodated.
2. Issuance of New OSCA ID	136	188	324	Have applied for OSCA ID to be included in the rooster of Senior Citizens in Bislig to avail the Benefits and privileges.
3. Replacement of Old OSCA ID	116	99	215	Old and dilapidated IDs were replaced with new identification cards.
4. Replacement of Lost OSCA ID	41	51	92	Lost IDs were replaced upon presentation of Affidavit of Loss or endorsement from the Chapter President.
5. Processing and Issuance of Purchase Slip	262	325	587	Senior Citizens were provided with Purchase Slip as requirement on the availment of 20% discount and exemption of 12% VAT on the purchases of medicines and hospitalization.
6. Processing and Issuance of Purchase Booklet	241	274	515	Senior Citizens were issued and provided with Purchase Booklet to avail of 5% discounts on the purchases of prime and basic commodities.
7. Processing of Mortuary Assistance	24	27	51	Direct dependents of deceased Senior Citizens have applied for mortuary assistance, applications were processed upon presentation of necessary documents. A deceased Senior Citizen, thru his/her dependent, will receive an amount of Php3,000.00 as mortuary assistance.
8. Processing of Aid to Individual in Crisis Situation (AICS) - Financial/Medical Assistance	6	22	28	Senior Citizens themselves and/or their relative/s applied for financial/medical assistance. A Senior Citizen will receive an assistance depending on the assessment of the assigned worker.
