ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT

PURPOSE OF CREATION:

A. To make Official Record of a complete list on Barangay population thru conducting CENSUS of actual residents in the 24 Barangays of Bislig City identifying the number of IPs/ICCs and migrants by knowing also the lifestyle and economic condition.

Partial CENSUS records from July 1 to December 2019 for the first six (6) of the 24 Barangays.

B. To help, guide and support all ICCs/IPs request of assistance to any concern offices in the City government of Bislig from July 1 to present. This office is available to help and assist 17 IPs.

C. To act and implement whatever instructions and orders from the City Mayor Florencio C. Garay particularly the issue of Tinuy-an Falls operation, management and development in Brgy. Burboanan.

D. Last September 1, 2019 the IPs affairs initiate and implement the stop over for not less than 5 minutes in the upper part of the Tinuy-an Falls purposely to record all entering vehicles including passengers, drivers and plate numbers and to inform local and foreign visitors that they are entering a National Protected Area subject for regulation. All visitors are informed that all vendors are only allowed in the stop over area since businesses inside the area is prohibited.

E. Letter protest/complaint to the approval of CADT 239 of Manobo in Sitio Soti, Brgy. Burboanan.

1. Letter protest of Atty. Mamerto B. Alciso Jr. addressed to the NCIP Regional Director-Butuan City for cancellation or revocation of CADT 239 of Manobo in Sitio Soti, Brgy. Burboanan dated November 7, 2019.
2. Letter complaint addressed to NCIP Chairman-Manila dates August 14, 2019 regarding the unlawful and illegal intrusion of Manobo in the Ancestral Domain of Mandaya Tribe Burboanan, unfair services and discrimination treatment of local NCIP personnel in Bislig City and Surigao del Sur.
3. Letter report/request to the DENR Secretary-manila dated August 14, 2019 regarding the continuous illegal logging activity and existing illegal well-armed group within the Tinuy-an Falls inside of the National Protected area as declared by R.A. No. 11038 (ENIPAS LAW).
4. Participants and coordinates during October 25,2019 dialogue/conference initiated by Tourism, IPs affair and City Mayor Florencio C. Garay with the presence of the NCIP-R13 Regional Director Ferdausi Cerna, OSAP Represented by Ma'am Decolet, 75th IB represented by Col Munda, DENR-CENRO Bislig, Manobo Officials of Sitio Soti, Mandaya Officials of Burboanan, Mandaya Lawyer Atty. Mamerto Alciso Jr. and other concern group, purposely to discuss and resolve issues observed in the areas of Tinuy-an Falls.
