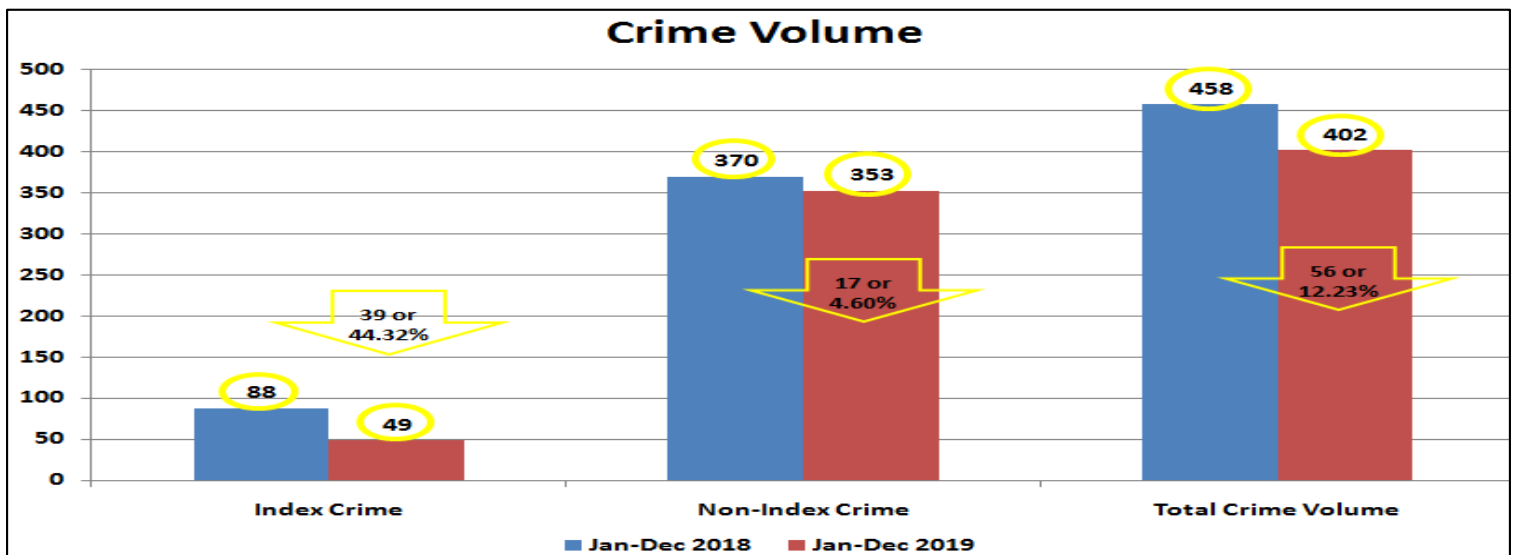

SITUATION UPDATE



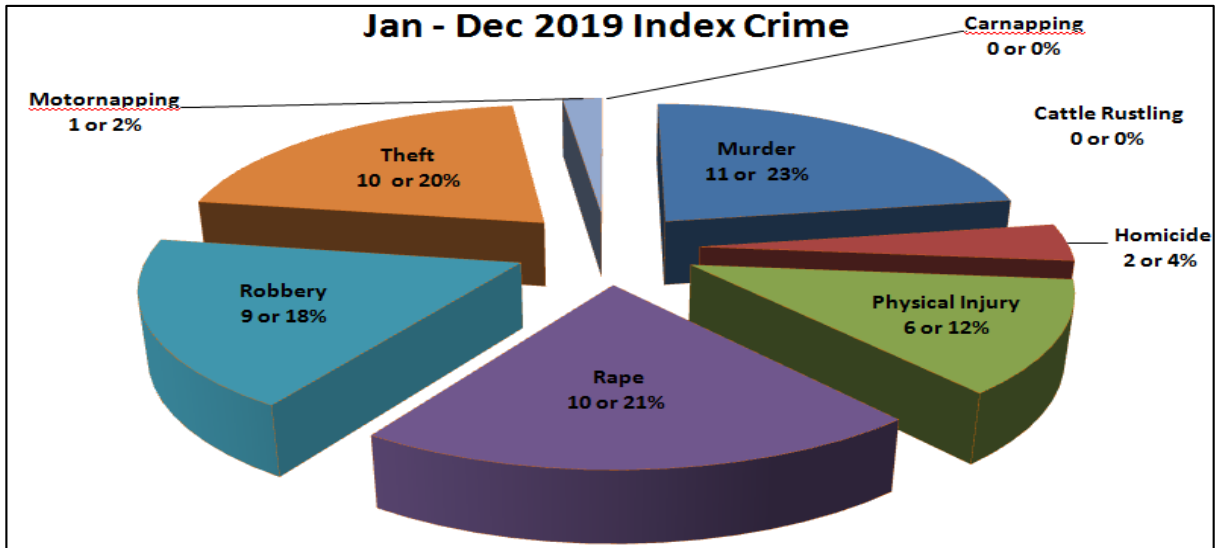
On Index Crime, for the period January to December 2019, it registered **49 incidents** of the Total Crime Volume, which is **39 incidents** or **4.32%** lower compared to year 2018 of same period which is **88 incidents**.

Non-Index Crime, for the period January to December 2019, it registered **353 incidents** of the Total Crime Volume, which is **17 incidents** or **4.60%** lower compared to year 2018 of same period which has **370 incidents**.

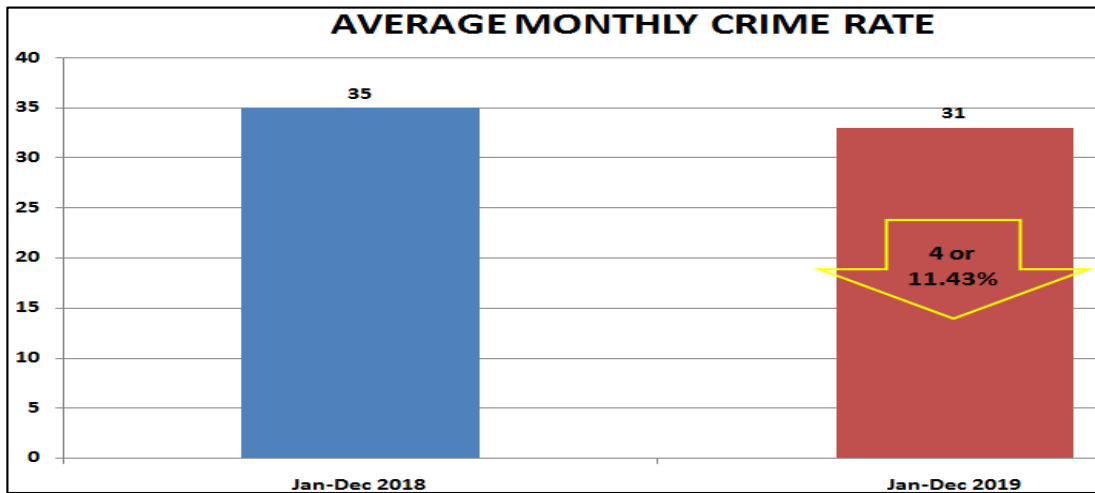
For the period from January to December 2019, the Total Crime Volume (TCV) is **402** which have **56 incidents** or **12.23%** lower as compared to the CY 2016 with **458 TCV**.

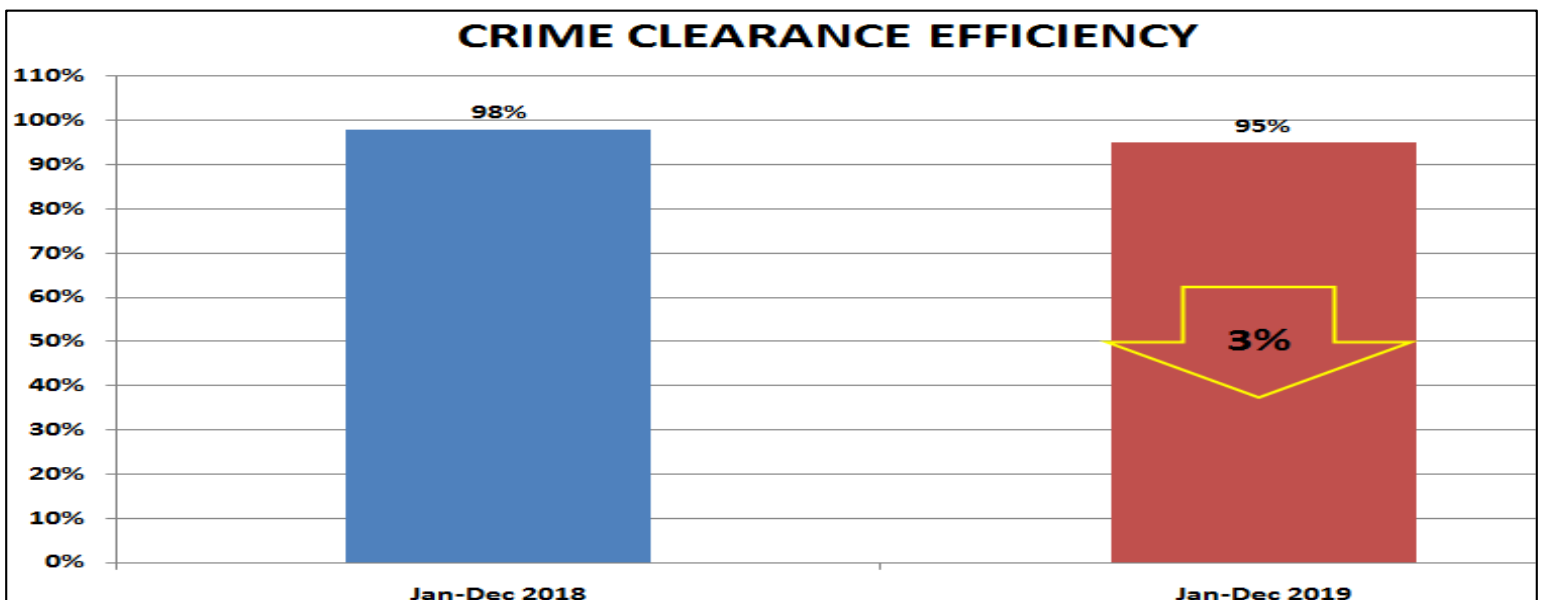
Shown is the comparative Crime Volume of 2019 against 2018



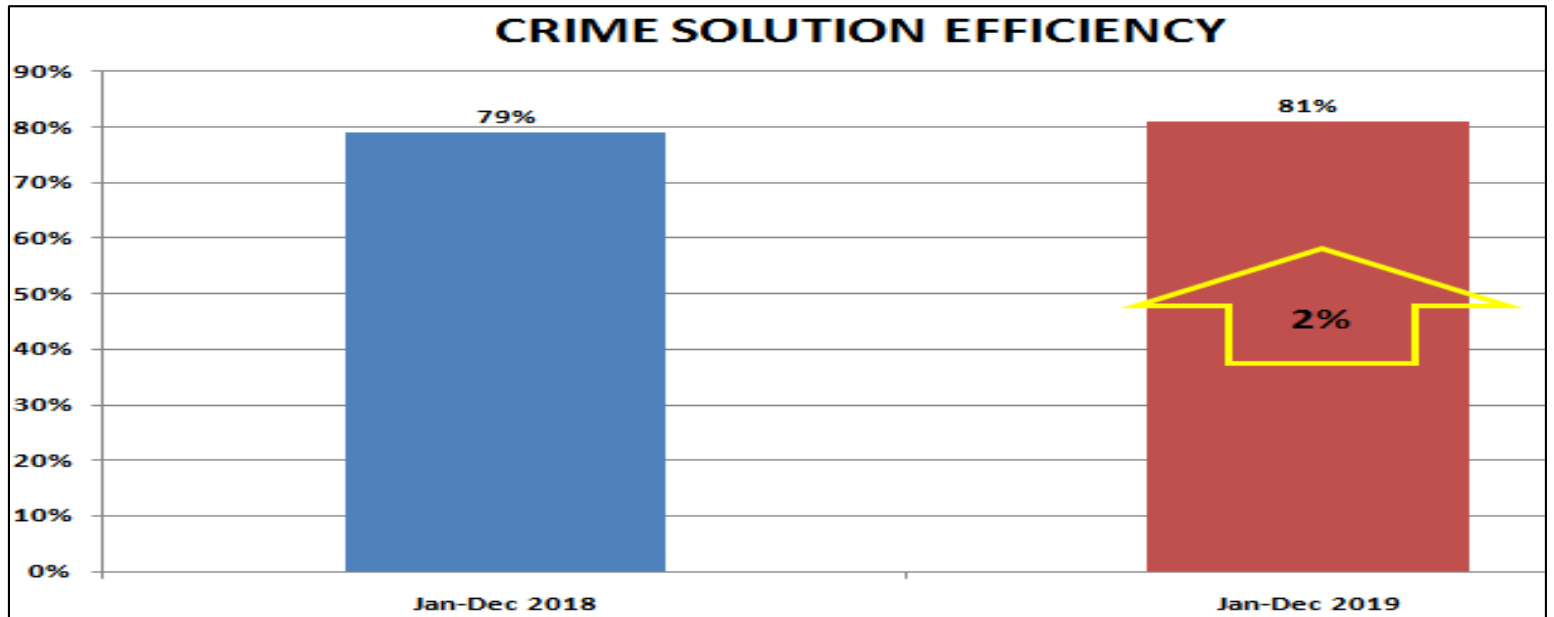
Of the Index Crimes, Murder is the most prevalent crime committed for the period with **11 incidents or 23%**, followed by Rape and Theft each with **10 incidents or 21% and 20%** respectively, next to the list is Robbery with **9 incidents or 18%** followed by Physical Injury with **6 incidents or 12%** then Homicide with **2 incident or 4%** and Motornapping with **1 incident or 2%** all of the Index Crime.



On the Average Monthly Crime Rate, from January to December 2019 it registered **31 incidents** for the period, which is **4 incidents or 11.43%** lower as compared to year 2018 with **35 incidents** of the same period per 100,000 population per month over the period of 12 months.



On Crime Clearance Efficiency, for the period January to December 2019 it registered **95% or 383 crime incidents** were cleared a decrease of **3%** compared to 2018 which is **98%**.



On Crime Solution Efficiency, from January to December 2019, it registered **81% or 326 crime incident solved** an increase of **2%** compared to 2018 which is **79%**.
