EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 30
Series of 2020

"AN ORDER DECLARING THE ENTIRE CITY OF BISLIG UNDER GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (GCQ)."

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation No. 922 placing the country in a State of Public Health Emergency;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation No. 929 declaring a State of Calamity in the entire country for a period of six (6) months;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 Inter-Agency Task Force has issued Resolution No. 11 allowing Local Government Units to declare a community Quarantine and providing specific parameters;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 also known as the Local Government Code provides that within their respective territorial jurisdiction, local government units shall ensure and promote health and safety of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Article 87 of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991 has specified the powers, duties and functions of the City Mayor aimed at promoting the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants necessitate the enforcement of community quarantine of the entire city to contain the transmission of corona virus among its residents and prescribing rules and regulations and sanctions against violation thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, I FLORENCIO C. GARAY, City Mayor of Bislig City, Surigao del Sur, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following during the duration of the community quarantine, to wit:

SECTION 1. General Community Quarantine Policies and Regulations. The following guidelines shall be strictly observed during the duration of the general community quarantine, to wit:

- a) All individuals in the City are hereby obliged to observe **social distancing** at least **one (1) meter** distant against each other.
- b) Wearing of face mask is **mandatory** when going out in public.
- c) The general population may go out of their homes only for purposes of accessing basic necessities.
- d) All individuals on the streets must carry and, whenever asked by law enforcement authorities, must present their **Quarantine/Work/Food/Travel/Medical Pass** whichever is applicable.
- e) Ages 0-20, 60 years old and above and those who are high health risk shall stay at home.
- f) All government offices must implement **skeletal workforce** and leave minimal employees to continue work in offices except those involved in security, health,

social services, sanitation, and disaster, who must continue to work on full operation.

- g) A **total liquor ban** is hereby imposed. All outlets are prohibited to sell or serve intoxicating liquors/beverages during the GCQ.
- h) Restaurants, catterias, food chains and the like are limited to **take out services only**.
- i) All mass activities and gatherings, **whether public, private or religious**, shall be cancelled.
- j) **Classes at all levels** (except online classes), whether public or private, are hereby **suspended** until further notice.
- k) Payments of electric, water, cable, internet and other similar bills should be extended.
- l) Priority and essential construction projects may resume in accordance with the guidelines as may be issued by the DPWH.
- m) Private establishments within Bislig City shall implement flexible work plan for their respective operations.
- n) Returning OFWs and homecoming students shall undergo mandatory quarantine for fourteen (14) days.


SECTION 2. Business Operations. Private businesses or establishments may resume their operations provided that social distancing and proper disinfecting procedures are strictly implemented. The following business establishments, however, **SHALL REMAIN TEMPORARILY CLOSED**, namely:

- a) Swimming pools, resorts and other tourism destinations;
- b) Cockpits;
- c) Hotels/Inns (except those used as quarantine facilities);
- d) Fitness Gyms;
- e) All courts/covered courts for team sports;
- f) Travel Agencies;
- g) Karaoke Houses;
- h) Beer Houses;
- i) Amusement Places;
- j) Internet Cafes;
- k) Bingo and E-games; and
- l) Others establishments for leisure or entertainment.

Non-leisure shops/establishments are allowed to reopen but **should limit entry of shoppers** and implement mandatory temperature check and mandatory use of masks and alcohol.

SECTION 3. Resume of Public Transportation. Public transport can operate at reduced capacity to ensure social distancing, provided the following guidelines shall be strictly observed:

- a) Public Utility **Jeepney/Multicab** shall limit Fifty percent (50%) passengers of its normal seating capacity;
- b) **Tricycle** shall accommodate a maximum of Two (2) passengers per trip;



- c) **Umbak** shall limit two (2) passengers per trip;
- d) **Trisikad** shall limit one (1) passenger per trip;
- e) One (1) back rider shall be allowed for **private single motorcycle**, provided he/she is a family member of the driver;
- f) Paragraphs **A to E** of this section are exceptions to the one (1) meter social distancing;
- g) Any violation of Paragraphs **A to E** would warrant confiscation of the motor vehicle of the violator;
- h) **Buses** are allowed at half their regular capacity, but not exceeding twenty-five (25) passengers;
- i) **Van** operators should limit to half of their regular capacity, but not exceeding nine (9) passengers; and
- j) No passenger allowed for *habal-habal*.
- k) Airports and seaports may operate only for the movement of goods. Passenger vessels are prohibited.

SECTION 4. Ingress and Egress of the City. The following are the guidelines for entry and exit of goods and individuals in the City of Bislig, to wit:

- a) All persons entering Bislig City must be checked for signs and symptoms in the established checkpoints and subject to questioning for travel history;
- b) Non-residents who intend to enter the City for **work, procurement of medicines and banking/money transfer transactions** may be granted entry upon presentation of the required documents at designated checkpoints;
- c) Non-residents who intend to enter the City for purposes other than that provided in the preceding paragraph must obtain permit or authorization from the local chief executive of Bislig City;
- d) All vehicles carrying essential food commodities, agri-fishery products and the like must be allowed passage through the checkpoints. The City Agriculture Office shall implement the "Food Pass" in every checkpoint;
- e) Only the driver and helper of the delivery trucks should be allowed to enter;
- f) Drivers and passengers of exempted vehicles will be subjected to temperature check and presentation of medical certificate;
- g) Workers from Bislig City are allowed to work outside Bislig and should be allowed to enter the city after work; and
- h) **Residents** of Bislig will be allowed to enter the City after showing legitimate proof/s of residence but only from **4AM to 9PM**.
- i) **Requirements at borders:**

1. Food Pass.

- Valid ID;
 - Vehicle Registration;
 - Proof of Employment/Schedule of Duty;
 - Delivery Receipts/Sales invoice;
 - Declaration Form; and
 - Cargo Manifest.
2. Work Pass.
- Agency issued ID; and
 - Certification showing Proof of Employment or Schedule of Duty.
3. Travel Pass.
- Valid ID and proof of residence;
 - Medical certificate from Local Health Officer that individual/s in transit is not PUM or PUI; and
 - Vehicle Registration.

SECTION 5. Imposition of Curfew. A city-wide curfew shall be observed from 9:00 o'clock in the evening to 4:00 o'clock in the morning. The following shall be exempted: security guards, construction workers, fishermen, rescue personnel, firefighters, drivers transporting workers going home, medical workers, those transporting patients or cadavers, those reporting or seeking for response of an emergency.


SECTION 6. Penalty. Any violation or wilful disobedience of the provisions of this Executive Order shall be penalized in accordance with Article 151 of the Revised Penal Code for Resistance or Disobedience to a Person in Authority or his Agents with a penalty of imprisonment ranging from **One (1) month and One (1) day to Six (6) months** and/or fine not exceeding **P100,000**.

SECTION 7. Separability Clause. In the event that any provision in this Order or any part hereof is declared invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional, the provisions not affected thereby shall remain in force and in effect.

SECTION 8. Repealing Clause. All orders, rules and regulations, other issuances, or parts hereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect at 12:01AM of MAY 01, 2020 and shall remain in force unless sooner revoked or amended.
