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**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 30-B**  
Series of 2020

**“AN ORDER PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS ON LIQUOR BAN AND MASS GATHERINGS UNDER EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 30, S. 2020.”**

**WHEREAS**, the World Health Organization declared a pandemic on the spread of Covid-19 disease;

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Presidential Proclamation No. 922 placing the country in a State of Public Health Emergency and Presidential Proclamation No. 929 declaring a State of Calamity in the entire country for a period of six (6) months;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 30 was issued by Mayor Florencio C. Garay placing the entire city to General Community Quarantine (GCQ) which limits certain business operations;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to allow certain businesses and business establishments to operate to cater the needs and demands of the general public and to gradually refurbish the economy of the city;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I FLORENCIO C. GARAY**, City Mayor of Bislig City, Surigao del Sur, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following, to wit:

**SECTION 1. Liquor Ban.** The 24-hour liquor ban is hereby partially lifted and shall be strictly imposed from 5pm to 5am. However, no liquor, alcohol or any other intoxicating drink shall be consumed in public until after the quarantine is lifted.

**SECTION 2. Liquor and Cigarette Products.** The entry of liquor and cigarette products shall be allowed from all check points, provided, proper disinfection procedures are strictly observed. Stores are permitted to sell liquor (5am to 5pm only) and cigarette products but **strictly no smoking and drinking allowed in public places.**

**SECTION 3. Mass Gatherings.** Section 4, Paragraph 12 of the Omnibus Guidelines of the Inter-Agency Task Force is hereby adopted, to be read as follows: *“Mass gatherings that are unauthorized, non-work essential or are entertainment related – such as movie screenings, concerts, and sports events – are prohibited. While adhering to the prescribed minimum health standards, religious gatherings are not encouraged but in any case should be not more than ten (10) persons.”*


Mass gatherings shall include gatherings for religious, civic, educational and other purposes except entertainment. Wearing of face masks, social distancing and no touch policy shall be strictly followed at all times. All persons and/or institutions must ensure that proper disinfection procedures are implemented before and after said gatherings.

**SECTION 4. Separability Clause.** In the event that any provision in this Order or any part hereof is declared invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional, the provisions not hereby affected shall remain in force and in effect.

**SECTION 5. Repealing Clause.** All orders, rules and regulations, other issuances, or parts hereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 6. Effectivity.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless sooner revoked or amended.
